

Spool Quilt Along - Month 7

Skill Level: Easy

This month's block is fun and colorful. There's lots of cutting and piecing, but the result is worth it. This design would also look great as an accent pillow.

Finished Quilt Approximately: 72" x 72"

Finished Block Size: 12" x 12"

Cutting Directions for Block #7:

From Fabric A:

- Cut two 1-3/4" x WOF strips, recut into thirty-two 1-3/4" squares
- Cut one 4-1/2" square

From each of Fabric G, H, I, J, K, L, M and Q:

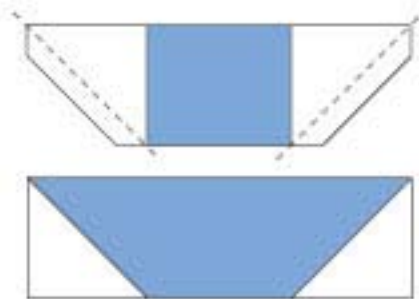
- Cut two 1-3/4" x 4-1/2" strip
- Cut one 2" x 4-1/2" strip

Sewing Directions:

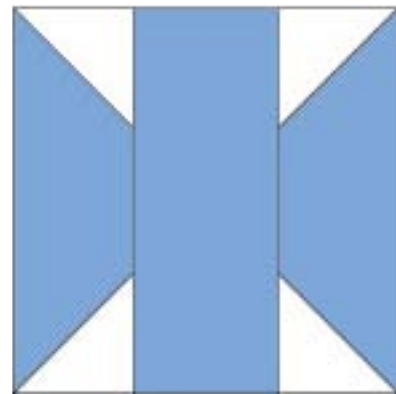
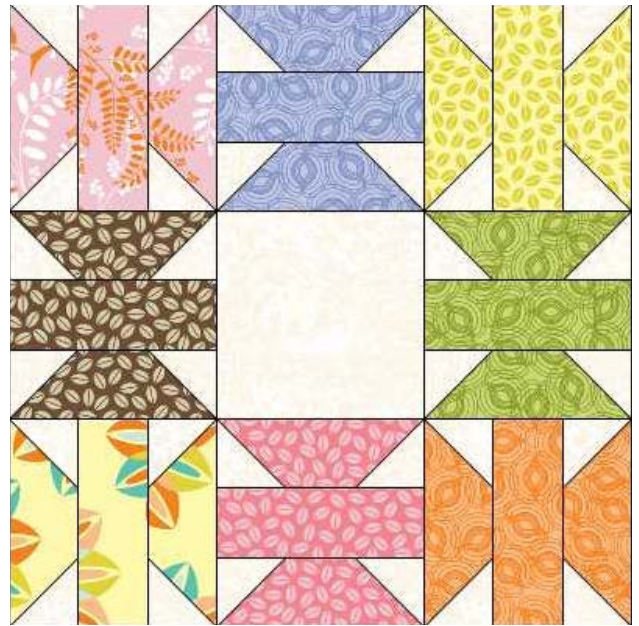
1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of each of the Fabric A 1-3/4" squares. Lay two marked Fabric A squares on a Fabric G 1-3/4" x 4-1/2" strip as shown.



2. Sew across the marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4" and press seam under the print fabric. Make a second identical unit.



3. Sew a pieced Fabric A/G unit to each side of the 2" x 4-1/2" Fabric G strip to complete the spool square.



4. Make seven more spools squares in the same manner, one each with Fabrics H, I, J, K, L, M and Q.

5. Referring to the quilt graphic, lay out the eight spool squares with the Fabric A 4-1/2" square in three rows of three squares each. Stitch squares into rows then sew the rows together.

That's it!! You've successfully completed the seventh spool block. Be sure to come back and get the directions for Spool Block #8 in October.
